more complicated than most communities, but it's also a history that deserves celebration.


Local organizations including the BDRC have formed a Bicentennial Committee to plan for festivities in 2025. There are lots of great ideas

Baltimore Receives Forestry Grant – Take the Survey

The Village of Baltimore recently was awarded a \$40,000 grant from the Ohio Dept. of Natural Resources. The federal infrastructure funds will be used to first evaluate trees on Village property including street rights of way. The second phase of the project will include priority pruning and removal work. The final phase will be tree planting in the spring of 2025. Wizardly "Flourish in Books" Shop Returned... Like Magic


The Flourish in Books free book shop returned to the Opera House on August 10 as
