Village Bicentennial Coming in 2025 – Celebrating 200 Years





And thanks to Chris & Angi Miller and Generation Farms for the wonderful seasonal decorations out front!








Nostalgics Christmas Concert Dec. 8 at the Opera House


Make a note on your calendar now! This big band does Christmas right! The show will be Sunday Dec. 8 at 3 PM. Admission is
