



Victoria Players Children's Theater Receives FCF Grant

The VPCT applied for a grant this spring from the Fairfield County Foundation (FCF). The FCF offers several grant programs, and has been a generous supporter of the VPCT and BDRC in the past.

One of the grant programs is advised by the FCF's Youth Advisory Committee. The VPCT requested funds to replace numerous microphones that were no longer functional.

We are delighted to share that the application was successful! The VPCT received \$2,000 as a memorial gift from the George and Dollie L. Zimpfer Fund of the Fairfield County Foundation, in collaboration with the Youth Advisory Committee. That calls for a mic drop (but we'll drop the old mics, not the new ones!)
